

2020 Corporate Games Bowling General Guidelines

Remember to:

STAY HOME IF YOU HAVE ANY OF THE [COVID-19 SYMPTOMS](#) SET IN PLACE BY THE CDC AND LINCOLN-LANCASTER CO. HEALTH DEPARTMENT

If you are awaiting test results for COVID-19, DO NOT come to any of the CG events

Cover mouth when coughing or sneezing

Wash hands or use alcohol-based hand sanitizer

Avoid touching eyes, nose and mouth

Avoid close contact and distance yourself from other people

- **Self-Screen at Home:** We are requesting you to screen at home, this includes taking your own temperature and verifying that it is under 100.4 degrees Fahrenheit
- **Waiver:** All athletes must sign the online waiver which includes Covid-19 language prior to the competition
- **Plan:** NSC Staff will work with all facilities on a restroom/equipment/seating sanitization plan
- **Masks:** Masks are required in Lancaster County when indoors.
 - Spectators are required to wear masks at all times when indoors (5+ in age)
 - Athletes are required to wear masks before and after competition, but not during
- **Clean:** All athletes and spectators will be reminded to wash hands often and use hand sanitizer stations where applicable
 - All high-touch areas will be sanitized with spray or wipes at least every two hours
- **Spectators:** All athletes will be encouraged to only allow immediate family to join them at the competition site.
- **Separation:** Provide spacing (Bleachers & Common Gathering Points)
 - Regular social distancing announcements will be made
 - Volunteers will be enforcing social distancing
 - At high traffic/indoor facilities, X's will mark 6 foot distancing requirements on the ground and bleachers where necessary
 - Where needed floor arrows will mark flow of traffic
- **Capacity:** Onsite staff will monitor maximum capacity guidelines at each sport venue
- **Awards:** If applicable: Awards will not be draped over athlete necks. All Awards Ceremony volunteers will hand individually wrapped medals to athletes wearing gloves and face masks.

Sport Specific Notes:

To help ensure a safe environment for all Corporate Games participants and Sun Valley Lanes & Games team members, multiple changes listed below have already been implemented for the 2020 bowling event. Additional on-site announcements and reminders regarding “lane courtesy” will be presented to all competitors onsite.

1. Reformatted all competitions – All competitors will remain on one pair of lanes. Also, by eliminating the “stepladder” round of all the events, bowlers will avoid contact with other players on lanes that have been previously used and not be sanitized.
2. Limited squad sizes – The size of all squads have been limited to no more than 5/players/lane. The physical size and layout of Sun Valley Lanes allows for teams to remain 6 feet apart while seated by seating at specific chairs at each lane table.
3. Rescheduled all squads. The squads have been spaced apart to allow Sun Valley Lanes staff to clean/sanitize all of the tables, chairs and touch screens between squads.
4. Lane Courtesy Will Be Enforced - by practicing common bowling etiquette known as “1-lane courtesy”, bowlers will be able to maintain the recommended social distancing space with all lanes in use other recommendations regarding lane courtesy include.
 1. Stay on your lane as much as possible
 2. Avoid high fives and other physical contact with Sun Valley team members and fellow competitors.
 3. Sun Valley staff will be wearing masks.
 4. Although some competitors will have their own equipment, participants using house equipment should leave the equipment on the lanes when done with competition. Sun Valley Lanes staff will sanitize all used items.
5. All event entries have been prepaid, thus greatly reducing the amount of bowling transactions with Sun Valley staff.
6. To reduce the number of spectators, all entrants are encouraged to limit spectators to immediate family members, or none is possible.
7. During competition, please sit at the tables/seats indicated by Sun Valley Lanes staff.
8. Squad scheduling and squad sizes have been altered to allow the Sun Valley staff to clean and sanitize the bowlers area between each squad. Please follow their instructions accordingly.
9. Please remember to “keep pace” while bowling, allowing the person to the right to have the right-of-way. By keeping pace, bowlers should be able to remain socially distant.
10. Due to construction activities at Sun Valley Lanes, bleachers will not be available.
